LESSON 1 ***Evolution***

1. Q. What made you?

8. Q. What do we mean when we say that Evolution is an impersonal process?

LESSON 3

16. Q. Is Evolution the only possible Explanation for the origins of life?

A. Yes; Evolution is the only possible Explanation for the origins of life.

27. Q. Has any one ever reproduced the Big Bang in the Laboratory?

A. Of course not! That cannot ever be replicated in a Laboratory.

28. Q. And what is so "Scientific" about THAT?

A. All those who want to be accepted by the community of knowledgeable, responsible, and informed Scientists and other Influential Persons, and want to get good-paying jobs must believe in the Big Bang. Those who do not are marginalized as stupid, ignorant, superstitious creationists and/ or Christians. Which side do YOU want to be on??.

LESSON 5

AFTERWORD

This not-so-subtle satire on the alleged scientific basis of evolution is made available as a public service to assist those who would like to point out some of the gaping holes in the arguments put forth to defend the doctrine of “evolution” of species from other species, and ultimately, from nonliving matter. It is not intended to exhaust the subject. Much more could be said, and this little effort may be expanded in the future.

No one, of course, is challenging here the concept of adaptation *within* a species (or “micro-evolution”), such as has been observed for centuries, long before Charles Darwin adopted and publicized the notion of gradual adaptations capable of producing a *new* species.

By taking Evolutionist arguments against the scientific validity of Special Creation, or “Intelligent Design”, and applying them to Evolution, I have shown that Evolution is every bit as “unscientific” as “Creationism”, and requires just as much religious “faith” to believe in it. Nay, it requires even *more* faith to believe in Evolution, for, unlike “Creationism”, it requires its adherents to believe in effects without a cause, in a plan without a planner. Evolution is, indeed, merely a *belief*, held and promoted with evangelical devotion and tenacity to absolve its believers of the responsibility that comes with recognizing the obvious fact of Creation.

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
